Lunch was followed by presentations, after which each participant was invited to recommend \$300 in grants to be disbursed however they wished. As each prospective grantee began with \$200, a total of \$5,300.00 was awarded to the following programs: Miami Children's Chorus, Shake-A-Leg, St. Alban's Child Enrichment Center, His House Children's Home, Coral Gables Woman's Club May Van Sickle Children's Dental Clinic, Greater Miami Jewish Federation's Community Kosher Food Bank, Sunil Social Services Home (orphanage in India), and Jr. Orange Bowl Sports Ability Games.
